Please could we have any bike inner tubes you may have spare as they make an excellent grippy surface for Year 5s grippy wheel project! Please drop them off at reception.


Dear Parents

Ralph's Ancient Find!

Exciting news from the world of paleontology as Ralph from Dyson class has made an amazing discovery!

Ralph was hunting for crystals and shells around the rocks off Northern Brittany's coastline, and found an object that experts agree dates from either the Bronze or Copper Ages (3500BC-1200BC).

Several museums, including the Natural History Museum and the Musee de Prehistoire in Brittany, have tried to identify the object with ideas ranging from an arrow head to a decorative finishing from an ancient trunk.



One thing that is certain is that it belongs to the French State and the Museum of Brittany would like it back to be part of their display!
