*I want to change the way people think about sharks because sharks aren't the monsters of our seas and my goal was to stop people from treating them that way.*

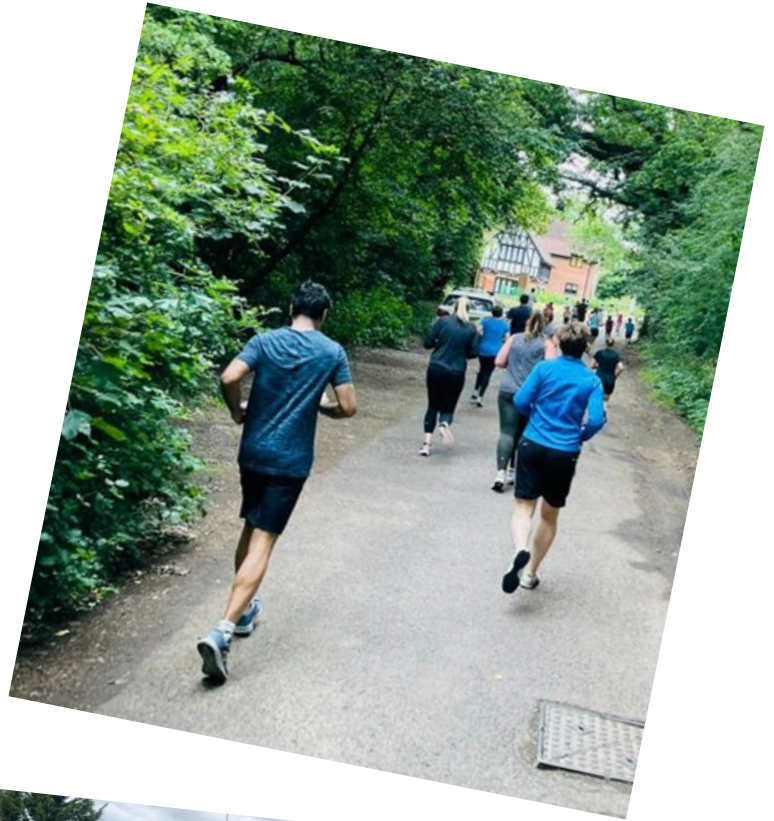

# School Fund Donations
